



Street-level navigation:

Grand will be closed from the I-64 off-ramp to Chouteau (marked with stripes). The nearest detours (marked in purple) are Vandeventer to the west and Compton to the east. The I-64 exit and entrance from Grand will remain open.

Highway navigation:

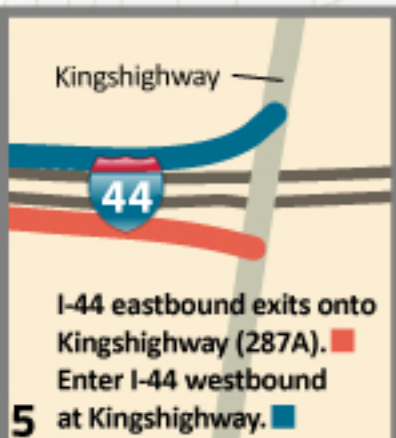
Highway exits and entrances will not be affected by the Grand Viaduct construction. Insets of exit/entrance details are for I-64 and I-44 exits between Jefferson and Kingshighway. **Dark blue** represents a westbound entrance ramp, **light blue** a westbound exit ramp. **Red** represents an eastbound entrance ramp, **orange** an eastbound exit ramp.

Metro:

When the Grand Metrolink station is open (most of the time), the #70 Grand bus will board on Scott Avenue and will rejoin Grand at Chouteau (southbound) or Forest Park (northbound). In the first couple weeks, when the train does not stop at Grand, the #70 will go to Union Station to pick up passengers. On the few weekends when trains will not run between Union Station and the Central West End, buses will take Metrolink passengers between those stations.

Getting around Grand

The Grand Viaduct, from I-64 to Chouteau, will close beginning March 14. It will be closed to traffic for about 14 months. Here's how to get around while the bridge is out.
